Important Notes!

People doing race officer / rescue boat duty will be awarded their average points for the series. People are welcome to swap dates with others to suit, however **failure to fulfil a duty will result in non-discardable points of DNC+5 for that evenings races**. Courses are as per the course sheet. Course type and number of rounds should be displayed on the committee boat whiteboard prior to the start of each race. First start each week is at **1745** so make sure you get there in time! Usually sufficient to have the RIB on the water by around **1720** which gives enough time to set the courses and set up the start line.

Depending on the size of the fleet 2 people may be required to record finish times. Kellie will be able to assist until around Xmas by which time we will need Bruce's crane to get her into the RIB. The post xmas roster will be prepared once we know who is sailing in the series. The intent is that people will only be required to do a maximum of 2 duties per year.

Target race length is 30 minutes give or take 10 minutes. Some evenings are tight for time so try to get the evening started on time, especially if course changes are likely to be required.

Fast fleet is considered to be Laser, Radial, Splash, Mistral, Finn, Farr 3.7, Contender, Javelin, Flying Dutchman, MG, Sunburst with kite (for the masochists!), etc.

Slow fleet is considered to be Starling, Flying Ant, Sunburst no kite, P Class, Optimist (including wing sail), etc
